The School of Theatre supports this mission through meaningful connections between audiences and our mainstage work, creative entry points for new audiences, providing tools for artists and students to harness their imaginative power, and immersive training for future theatre makers.

REGISTRATION POLICIES:

All registrations are processed in the order they are received. Registrations will be accepted until the class is full or until the end of the first week of class, whichever comes first. Returned checks: A \$25 service charge will be attached to any check returned by the bank due to insufficient funds. Class confirmations: After your registration is processed, you will receive information confirming your spot in the class. General cancellation policy: If you cancel 24 hours or more before the first class meeting begins, we will refund tuition less a \$50 processing fee per class. If you cancel within 24 hours before the first class meeting begins, we will refund tuition less a \$75 processing fee. If you cancel within 24 hours after the first class meeting, we will refund half the tuition amount. And 24 hours or more after the first class meeting, no refund will be given.

After 24 hours after the first class meeting, no refund will be given.
