When a father makes a fateful decision to preserve his family's hard-won success, the aftershocks ripple far beyond his home and community. Featuring Golden Globe and Emmy Award-winner **Jimmy Smits** and acclaimed actress — and real-life partner — Wanda De Jesús, Berkeley Rep Associate Artistic Director **David Mendizábal** (*Mexodus*) brings a bold new perspective to this American classic through a lens of race, ethnicity, and class — maintaining the original text while sharpening its themes of justice and inequity. This powerful revival reveals a tragedy where the pursuit of prosperity collides with the reality of who America was built to serve.

"I have always felt that *All My Sons* is one of the greatest plays in the American canon. Every line, every silence serves a purpose," said **Mendizábal**. "It's a privilege to direct this dream cast in a production I hope resonates deeply with audiences today in the San Francisco Bay Area."
